

OPPORTUNITIES FOR OUTREACH

Below are a few outreach opportunities. Contact the Flip or the church if you are interested in participating or want more information.

Friends of Internationals - Free Lunch on Wednesdays for International students. Each week FOI needs 5-6 volunteers to make and serve 4-5 pots of soup, some fruit, and cookies.

Internationals Talk time - Fridays at First Baptist Church in Corvallis 3rd floor, 7:15 pm to 8:30 pm. Conversation ideas are provided each week as you sit around a table helping international OSU students hone their English-speaking skills.

Prison Outreach from Home - Volunteers are needed to help facilitate Christian based correspondence programs for incarcerated men and women. There are no special skills needed. Any Christian with a desire to serve and help others is welcome. All materials are supplied and our facilitators are all anonymous, using first names only. Volunteers work from home at a time convenient for them.

Community Outreach to Children - Southside Church in South Corvallis has a weekly outreach to youth: dinner, games, teaching, and pouring love into little ones. There are a variety of ways you can volunteer.

The GOD Test - Start a conversation, ask questions. The GOD Test helps begin dialogue on the critical issues of *faith, skepticism, and the meaning of life*. This is used on campus by our missionary Jon Williamson. www.thegodtest.org

Prayer Walking - It looks like two friends having a conversation, but with eyes open they are praying over people and homes as they walk along "preparing the ground" for future outreach.

Door to Door - "We are here to care for this community. Is there anything you or your family need that we could pray and ask God to help? May we speak a blessing over you and your household? May we come back next week and tell a story from the Bible?"
