

OAKVILLE YOUTH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



Norman and Pat Coon and their family started the Oakville Youth Memorial Scholarship Fund in June 1986 as a memorial to Charlene Coon Gilmour.

Awarded annually for scholastic achievement, potential, or financial need, the scholarship is given to selected students who reside within the Oakville Parks and Recreation District or are active in the Oakville Presbyterian Church.

From the scholarship's inaugural recipient Mike Cunningham in 1987, who went on to become a high school teacher in the area, the fund has benefited many students as they seek to continue their higher education.

The Oakville Youth Memorial Scholarship Fund is offering scholarships for the 2019-2020 academic year. To qualify, applicants must:

- Live within the Oakville Park and Recreation District Boundaries (see description of boundaries on the following page) **or** be active in the Oakville Presbyterian Church.
- Be a high school graduate by June 2019 or be a current college/university student that is 25 years of age or less.
- Send the completed application packet to the Scholarship Committee Chairpersons listed below. The application ***must be*** postmarked **by April 30, 2019** and only ***completed*** applications will be considered.

Scholarships are based on achievement, potential, financial need, and/or a combination of these.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION IS April 30, 2019

Students applying for the scholarship *may* be contacted for a personal interview after the deadline date and the recipients will be notified by the first week of June, 2019. If a student selected to receive this scholarship is unable to attend school during the 2019-2020 year, an alternate may be considered.

Oakville Park and Recreation District Boundaries

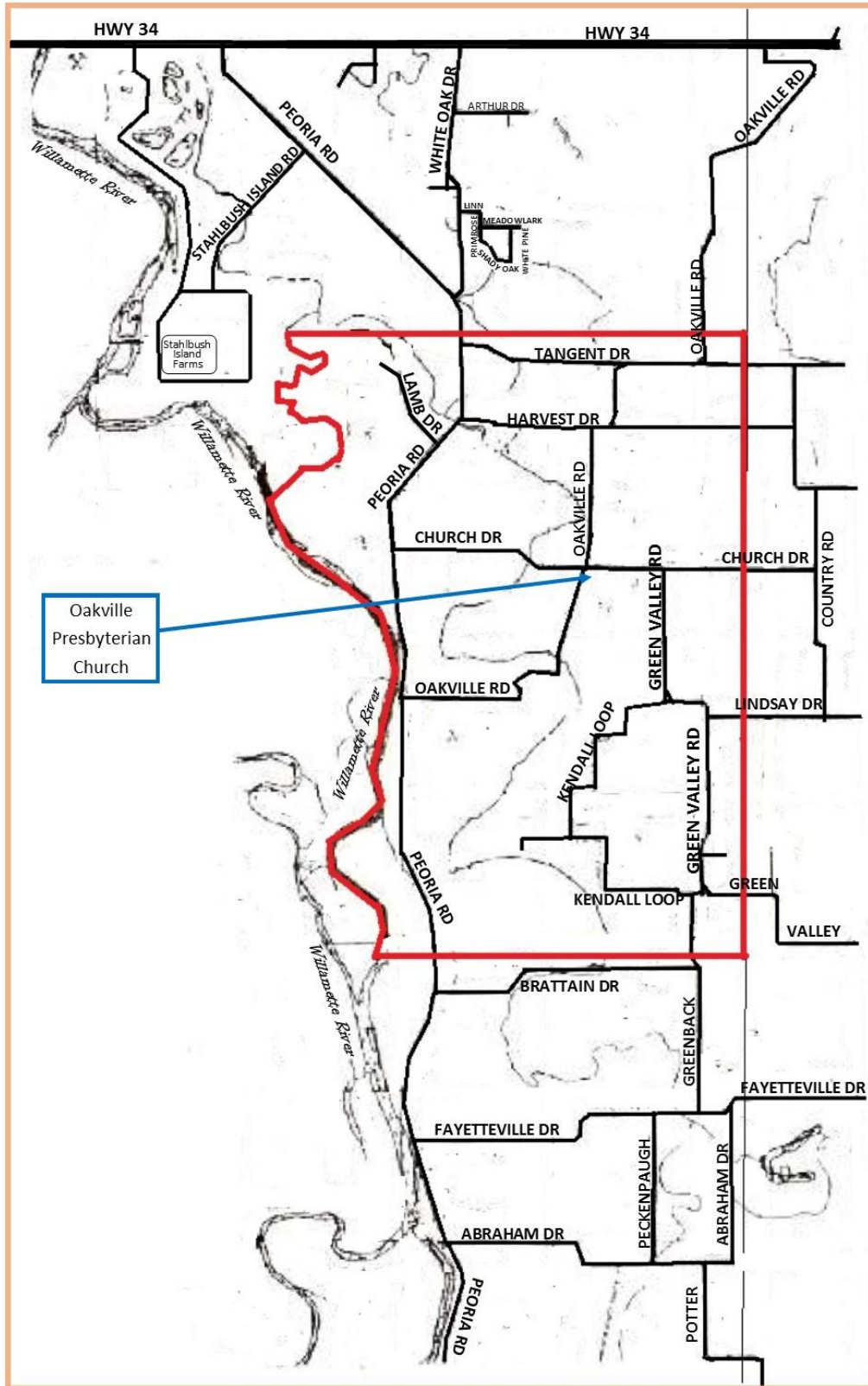
NW Corner: Muddy Creek just NW of Lamb Dr.

North Border: Addresses on Tangent Dr. from Peoria Rd at the west and to the railroad tracks to the East.

East Border: The Railroad tracks running from Tangent Dr. at the north to just north of Brattain Dr.

South Border: Railroad tracks just north of Brattain then due west to the Willamette River.
(Does not include Brattain Dr. addresses)

West Border: Willamette River



THE OAKVILLE YOUTH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The completed application packet to be sent to the Scholarship Committee is to include all the following items:

1. Personal Information Form
2. Personal letter telling of your high school or college activities, work experiences (if applicable) and your professional objectives.
3. Transcript of all your grades from high school and/or college.
4. List of three references (personal, scholastic, and employer).
5. Completed reference forms from the people listed as your three references.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION IS April 30, 2019

Must be postmarked no later than April 30, 2019.

Only completed applications will be considered. **If any** of the above five items are missing, or is postmarked after April 30, 2019 the application will be automatically **disqualified**.

You can email the Reference Forms to your three references and they can email them back to you, and you can then email them with the rest of your packet. You can also print them up, and your references can fill them out and you can put them in the mail or scan and email them with the rest of your packet.

You can request your high school and/or college to send your transcripts to the church, or you can obtain them and mail them with your printed packet, or you can scan and email them with your packet.

PERSONAL LETTER

EDUCATION

Tell us about your previous education; your current education experience and your future educational goals.

WORK EXPERIENCE

If any, what previous work experience do you have, and any current employment? What are your short term and long term career goals at this time?

FINANCIAL NEED

What educational expenses (tuition, books, supplies, etc.) do you anticipate for this coming school year? What financial resources do you anticipate to assist you with your educational plans? (Personal income, Parents/family, grants/scholarships/loans, etc.)
[Exact amounts are not necessary for any of these.]

TRANSCRIPTS

Be sure to obtain a copy of your high school or college transcripts in plenty of time and include them with your completed application packet!
